## PREPARING AVIATION'S FUTURE WORKFORCE



From 25 to 28 September 2012, aviation specialists and industry practitioners will gather in Singapore for the inaugural International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) TRAINAIR PLUS Global Symposium, to be held at the Raffles City Convention Centre. The meeting will be convened by ICAO and jointly hosted by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) and the Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA). It has been created as a platform to encourage the exchange of best practices, ideas and experiences on aviation training and to learn about the latest training trends, techniques and tools.

Themed *How to Prepare Tomorrow's Aviation Workforce with Today's Training Tools*, the ICAO TRAINAIR PLUS Global Symposium will discuss challenges facing the aviation training sector, competency-based training, current and emerging training trends and the TRAINAIR PLUS training framework. ICAO established the TRAINAIR PLUS training framework to strengthen the international aviation training network by facilitating the development and sharing of Standardised Training Packages (STPs). The STPs are developed in accordance to ICAO's guidelines and methodology and facilitates a harmonised high-quality training

standard. Members of the TRAINAIR PLUS programme can access the STPs and adapt the packages to fulfill local aviation training gaps and elevate their quality of training.
