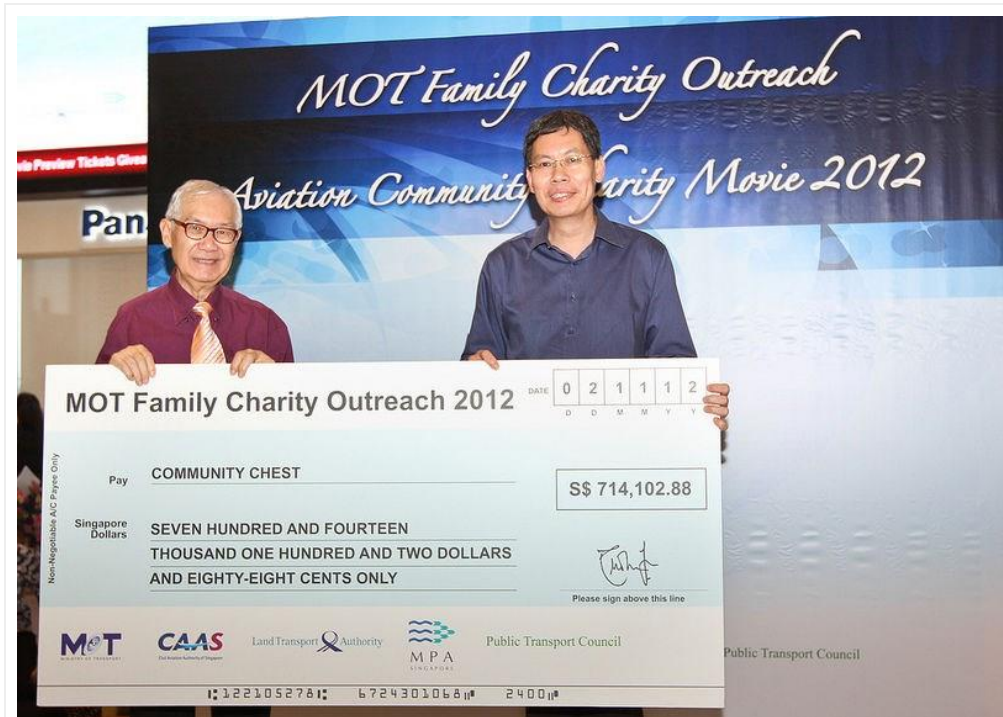


CAAS AVIATION COMMUNITY CHARITY MOVIE EVENT

In 2011, the Aviation Community Cares, an overarching platform for the aviation community to make a positive impact on society, was officially launched to reinforce this effort.

The CAAS Aviation Community Charity Movie was held on 2 November 2012 at Shaw Theatres Lido. Guest-of-Honour, Minister for Transport, Lui Tuck Yew, the management, staff and family members of the Ministry of Transport (MOT) and its statutory boards, corporate partners, as well as the beneficiaries of Sunlove Abode for Intellectually-Infirmed Limited,

participated in this meaningful family event and raised a total of \$121,528 for the Community Chest.
