A veteran in the aviation field, Ms Graham took some time out from her busy schedule in Singapore to share her experiences in aviation particularly as a woman in a male dominated industry at a dialogue session held at Temasek Polytechnic. Sharing her thoughts on what motivates her to be part of the aviation industry, she noted the many career prospects available in the aviation industry. She shared her insights on jobs such as air traffic controllers and aircraft accident investigators. She also highlighted the challenges aviation is facing today such as the high air traffic growth and manpower demand in South East Asia and the ever importance of aviation safety.

The dialogue session was part of the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS)'s youth outreach efforts to nurture a passion in aviation amongst tertiary-level students.
