SWISS RETURNS TO CHANGI AIRPORT



Swiss International Air Lines (SWISS), the national carrier of Switzerland, has announced that it will return to Singapore Changi Airport with the introduction of a daily non-stop service between Zurich and Singapore starting from May 2013.

With the commencement of SWISS's Singapore-Zurich service, Singapore will be linked to more than 50 cities in Europe. The new service adds an additional 1,500 weekly one-way seats, boosting capacity on the route by 54%. It will also provide more options for travellers from Singapore heading for Switzerland and Europe, and allow passengers from Switzerland to tap on Changi's connectivity to Southeast Asia and the Southwest Pacific.

SWISS will operate the new Singapore-Zurich service with A340-300 aircrafts in a 3-class configuration.
