

SAA WIDENS AVIATION TRAINING OFFERINGS WITH ICAO'S TRAINAIR PLUS CERTIFICATION

The Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA), the training arm of the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS), is now an International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) TRAINAIR *PLUS* Associate after successfully completing an ICAO TRAINAIR *PLUS* Programme assessment. This certification is testament to Singapore's ongoing commitment to enhance its training resources and capabilities and advance the aviation industry's knowledge.

The TRAINAIR Programme was established to facilitate improvements in safety and efficiency of air transport by helping civil aviation centres adopt high training standards. The TRAINAIR *PLUS*, an updated version of the programme, involves the development of Standard Training Packages (STPs) that members can share through a cooperative training network. As a TRAINAIR *PLUS* Associate, SAA can now tap into more than 90 STPs through the network and widen its offering of specialised aviation training courses.
