NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendment to the Air Navigation Order (S781/2005)

AIR OPERATOR CERTIFICATE APPLICATION FEE

The Air Navigation Order (ANO) has been amended by the Air Navigation Order 2005 (S781/2005)

The Air Navigation Order S781/2005 came into operation on 7 December 2005 incorporates an application fee of \$150,000 for new Air Operator Certificate (AOC) application.

The AOC application fee is applicable to new AOC application and is payable on submission of the AOC application.

This application fee will enable CAAS to recover the costs incurred in evaluating documents, organisational systems and processes of the applicant upon his application for an Air Operator Certificate. Other fees like the fees where functions are performed abroad continue to be applicable.

This fee is not applicable to AOC operators applying for re-issue of an existing Air Operator Certificate.
