**NOTIFICATION OF MEDICAL STATUS BY  
SINGAPORE FLIGHT CREW LICENCE HOLDERS**

1. In accordance with the Air Navigation Order, Part IV, subparagraph 20(7), a holder of a Singapore flight crew licence, other than a flight radiotelephony operator's licence, who:
  - a) suffers any personal injury involving incapacity to undertake the functions to which his licence relates;
  - b) knows or has reason to believe that she is pregnant;
  - c) requires continued treatment with prescribed medication; or
  - d) has received medical treatment requiring hospitalisation,

is required to inform CAAS in writing of such injury, illness, pregnancy or treatment as soon as possible.

2. In addition, a holder of a Singapore flight crew licence, other than a flight radiotelephony operator's licence, who suffers any illness involving incapacity to undertake those functions throughout a period of more than 20 days, is required to inform CAAS after a period of 20 days has elapsed in the case of any such illness.
3. With effect from 1 June 2008, a person, for the purposes of meeting the requirements in paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Circular, is to inform the following appointment holder in writing of his or her medical status:

4. Such a person is reminded not to exercise the privileges of his licence and related ratings until he has been cleared and pronounced fit by Chairman, CAMB.
