**FLIGHT CREW GROUND EXAMINATIONS SCHEDULE AND TIME-TABLE  
FOR YEAR 2008**

**1 AIRLINE TRANSPORT PILOT LICENCE GROUND EXAMINATIONS**

1.1 The Airline Transport Pilot Licence (ATPL) ground examinations schedule for 2008 is as follows:

1.2 The time-table for the three-day examinations is in Appendix 1.

Note:

- (i) The Aviation Law and HP&L examinations scheduled on the first day of the three-day examinations are reserved for candidates sitting the full ATPL examination. However, the Signals examination scheduled on the same day will be open to all candidates.
- (ii) Foreign Licence Conversion candidates who are exempted from the ATPL ground examinations but are required to sit for the Aviation Law, Flight Rules & Procedures, HP&L and Performance 'A' examinations may apply to sit these papers on the normal second and fourth Friday of each month.

## 2 **SINGAPORE ATPL EXAMINATIONS IN UK**

- 2.1 CAAS has made arrangement with the UK CAA International Services Department to enable applicants for Singapore professional pilot's licence to sit the Singapore ATPL examinations in the UK. This is to cater to those applicants who wish to prepare for the examinations through training with UK training institutions. However, all applicants intending to sit the Singapore ATPL examinations in the UK for the issue of a Singapore licence must obtain prior approval from CAAS.
- 2.2 The Singapore ATPL examinations in the UK will be administered and invigilated by UK CAA International Services Department. Candidates sitting the Singapore ATPL examinations in the UK must make their own arrangements for the payment of their examination fees and examination schedule dates directly to the UK CAA International Services Department. The fees payable will be in sterling pounds and will be equivalent to the fees specified in paragraph 5 below. The fees payable to the UK CAA may fluctuate depending on the prevailing exchange rate.

## 3 **PRIVATE PILOT LICENCE GROUND EXAMINATION AND THE PROFESSIONAL PILOT LICENCE AIRCRAFT TECHNICAL GROUP OF PAPERS, AVIATION LAW AND HP&L EXAMINATIONS**

- 3.1 The Private Pilot Licence (PPL) ground examinations and the Professional Pilot Licence Aircraft Technical Group of Papers, Aviation Law, Flight Rules & Procedures and HP&L examinations are conducted on every second and fourth Friday of each month. The closing dates for these examination sessions will be three working days before the dates of examinations. The commencement time of all examinations sessions is 0900 hours.

## 4 **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- 4.1 All applications for the flight crew ground examinations must be submitted on or before the closing dates at the following address:

Aviation Law, Flight Rules & Procedures	\$33 per examination
Signals	\$28 per examination
Aircraft Technical Papers	\$55 per sitting
