1. This form must be FULLY completed and received with the appropriate fee by the Flight Operations Section, CAAS, 4th Storey, PTB 2, Singapore Changi Airport, Singapore 819643 on Tuesday BEFORE the date of the examination. Crossed cheques must be made payable to "Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore." The applicant must produce his flight crew licence and certified flying log book for verification at the time of application.
2. Examinations are normally conducted on every 2nd and 4th Friday on each month, excluding Public Holidays..
3. Candidate must report at least 10 minutes BEFORE the scheduled time of the exam which begins at 0900 hours unless otherwise stated. Any candidate who is late will not be allowed to sit for the exam and fees paid will be forfeited.
4. If the candidate is unable to attend the exam, he should notify the Authority in writing at least 24 hours (1 day) before the exam failing which the exam fee will be forfeited.
5. Candidate is NOT permitted to bring his own reference materials or paper into the exam room.
6. Candidate is required to provide his own drawing and calculating instruments e.g. dividers, compasses, protractors and navigational slide rule for the NAV and MET paper only.
7. The use of calculators is NOT permitted in the exam except for Nav & Met and Performance "A". Calculators will be provided by CAAS.
8. Candidate must have his pilot's licence for identification on the day of the exam.
9. Unsatisfactory conduct, including the slightest infringement of exam regulations, may result in the candidate being disqualified in all subjects he has taken, and barred from further participation in the exam.
