Advisory to UA users


UA users are advised to conduct the following checks before flying their UA:

Do's:

- Read the product user manual to familiar yourself with the UA operating principles;
- Fly your UA outside no-fly zones. Visit OneMap.sg to learn where are the no-fly zones;
- Avoid flying your UA when there are strong winds, rain, or when there is poor visibility. Visit NEA.com.sg/weather to determine the weather condition before you fly your UA;
- Keep your UA within line of sight at all times;
- Check the condition of your UA and its controller. Follow the instructions in the user manual; and
- Land your UA immediately if an aircraft is spotted in the vicinity.

Don'ts:

- Never fly your UA over groups of people, public events, or areas full of people;
- Never carry hazardous substances on your UA;
- Never fly your UA under the influence of drugs or alcohol;
- Never fly your UA near any road;
- Never drop any item or discharge any substance from your UA;
- Never fly your UA in any area where there is an ongoing emergency response effort;
- Never fly your UA higher than 200ft above mean sea level; and
- Never fly your UA within 5km or any airport or military airbase.
