Our aviation landscape is getting increasingly complex. In order to be nimble and support the dynamic nature of the aviation industry, CAAS has established a modernised safety regulatory framework. This modernised framework seeks to better support growth plans of aviation businesses.

Safety regulations under the modernised framework are organised into clearly structured, focused and comprehensive modules of Air Navigation Regulations (ANRs). The new framework adopts a common numbering system with "Parts", which is well-recognised and used internationally.

The modernised safety regulatory framework will be rolled out in phases, in accordance with the CAAS' modernisation roadmap. The first segment that has been launched comprises Air Navigation Regulations (ANRs) relating to air operations, which take effect from 1 October 2018. These ANRs replace corresponding provisions in the existing Air Navigation Order and respective Regulatory Requirements. The ANRs can be found <u>here</u>.
