

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Publication of Air Navigation (101 – Unmanned Aircraft Operations) Regulations 2019

Please be informed that the Air Navigation (101 – Unmanned Aircraft Operations) Regulations 2019 (“ANR-101”) was published on 19 December 2019.

ANR-101 will replace Part XA of the Air Navigation Order in regulating unmanned aircraft operations. ANR-101 introduces the following:

- Revised requirements (purposes of use, and UA weight thresholds) for Operator and Activity Permits;
- Registration of an unmanned aircraft;
- UA basic training and UA pilot licence requirements;
- Requirements for organisations who seek to provide training leading to the grant of a UA basic training certificate or UA pilot licence; and
- Prohibition on the use of psychoactive substances by UA pilots.

Please refer to Regulation 1 of ANR 101 for the respective commencement dates of these regulations.
