

CAAS LAUNCHES NEW INITIATIVE TO PROMOTE STRONG SAFETY CULTURE IN AVIATION INDUSTRY

Safety in the aviation industry continues to be of paramount importance. To ensure that Singapore continues to embrace a strong safety culture and maintain the highest international safety standards and best practices for its air hub, the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) launched the *CAAS Safety Series*. Under this umbrella initiative, talks, workshops and forums will be organised to update the aviation industry on developments in safety policies, regulations and address any impact of new programmes or changes on the industry.

The inaugural event, held on 28 February at the Singapore Aviation Academy, covered recent significant changes made to Singapore's aviation regulations as well as International Civil Aviation Organization's (ICAO) new safety initiatives. By engaging industry partners regularly through this initiative, CAAS seeks to embed a more robust safety framework through greater collaboration and engagement with the aviation community. It is also a platform for industry players to actively and regularly participate and share their views with CAAS.
