It is certainly a privilege to be able to work on the most advanced jet engines in the world.

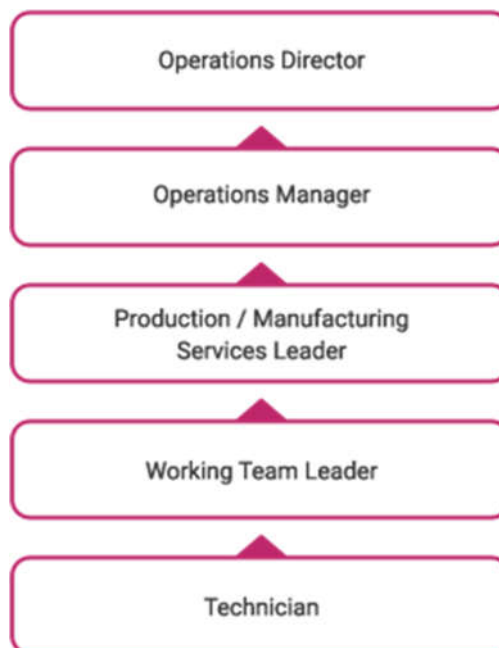
How I got into aviation
