## ADDITIONAL COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR AIRPORT WORKERS

1. Contact tracing investigations done by the Ministry of Health (MOH) revealed that some airport staff had continued to work despite having ARI symptoms. In addition, the cases' supervisor or colleagues were aware but these cases had continued to work while symptomatic, thus increasing the risk of transmission in the airport and community. In light of this information and the cluster associated with T3 Changi Airport, employers are required to put in place the following additional measures **immediately** to help reduce the risk of further transmission.

a. For all staff working at T3, employers are to do a one-time health sweep for all staff and to inform MOH if anyone is currently unwell or was unwell in the past week (from 3 May). If anyone is currently unwell or was unwell in the past week, they should be advised to self-isolate at home pending further instructions from MOH. The necessary information on these individuals should be compiled using **Annex A** and sent to the below mentioned officers via email immediately upon identification followed by a phone call to any one officer. MOH will then arrange for these individuals to be conveyed to hospital for testing and assessment.

b. For staff working at airport terminals other than T3, all employers are to remind their staff on the importance of monitoring for ARI symptoms (e.g. sore throat, cough, fever, runny nose) and not to come for work if unwell. Unwell staff should seek medical treatment promptly. Management/ Supervisors should be reminded not to allow symptomatic staff to work, and to advise them to seek medical treatment as soon as possible.
