COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AT AIRPORT – ROSTERED ROUTINE TESTING FOR AIRPORT WORKERS

This Circular 2021/35 is to be read in conjunction with CAAS Circular 2020/42 issued on 3 Nov 2020 and CAAS Circular 2021/06 issued on 14 Jan 2021.

2 As a further enhancement to the existing precautionary measures, relevant airport workers must be tested negative for COVID-19 and be rostered for Rostered Routine Testing (RRT), before they are deployed for work that meets the RRT criteria stipulated in CAAS circular 2020/42.

3 With immediate effect, any relevant employee who has not tested negative for COVID-19 and has not been rostered for RRT will not be permitted to work at the airport. His/her airport pass will be suspended if he/she is found working without having taken a RRT swab. Employers of relevant employees must therefore track and schedule their relevant employees for RRT promptly.
