**ILLEGAL EMPLOYMENT OF MIGRANT WORKERS AT CHANGI AIRPORT
TERMINAL 3**

We wish to bring to your attention that two migrant workers were employed illegally to work at Changi Airport Terminal 3 from 28 Apr to 6 May 21.

2 The two workers worked on 6 occasions during that period, clearing construction debris. Investigations by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) revealed that they were illegally employed by a construction company sub-contracted to perform demolition work. That sub-contractor is currently under investigation and its work pass privileges have been curtailed.

3 Airport partners and stakeholders are reminded that all migrant workers deployed to work at the airport must obtain valid work passes to work in Singapore, and must not perform work, or be employed to work, in breach of the conditions of their work pass. The illegal employment of a migrant worker is a serious offence. Please therefore ensure that safeguards and checks are put in place to prevent illegal employment of migrant workers.

4 Any company or individual found to have employed a migrant worker illegally may be prosecuted under the Employment of Foreign Workers Act. MOM will debar offending employers from employing migrant workers.
