## **UPDATE ON BORDER MEASURES FOR TRAVELLERS WITH TRAVEL HISTORY TO MYANMAR**

The Multi-Ministry Taskforce has been closely monitoring the global COVID-19 situation and will be tightening border measures given the worsening situation in Myanmar. Please refer to the Ministry of Health's press release in **Annex A**.

2 With effect from **15 July 2021, 2359 hours (Singapore time)**, until further notice,

- (a) all long-term pass holders and short-term visitors with recent travel history (including transit) to Myanmar within the last 21 days<sup>1</sup> will not be allowed entry into Singapore, or transfer/transit through Singapore. This will also apply to all those who had obtained prior approval for entry into Singapore; and
- (b) all travellers with recent travel history (including transit) to Myanmar within the last 21 days<sup>1</sup> will also be required to take a COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Test (ART)<sup>2</sup>, in addition to a COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test, on-arrival at Changi Airport.

3 Existing Not-To-Land (NTL) policies and procedures will apply for passengers who are denied entry into Singapore if they do not meet Singapore's prevailing entry requirements or who are not allowed to transfer/transit through Singapore.

4 Information on the additional requirement for all inbound and transit and transfer passengers will be updated in the IATA Timatic service.
