REVISED AIRPORT PASS SUSPENSION POLICY

This circular updates employers on the revised airport pass suspension policy for workers on Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) and Antigen Rapid Test (ART) Rostered Routine Testing (RRT).

2 Currently, workers who do not complete a swab within their PCR RRT regime will have their airport passes suspended the day after they miss their RRT swab. For ART, workers who miss 2 consecutive scheduled ART swabs will also have their airport passes suspended.

3 With effect from 26 Aug 2021, a one day grace period will be provided before suspension of airport passes. During the one day grace period, companies should submit the negative PCR swab results for workers who have done a PCR swab elsewhere via the following link: <https://go.gov.sg/caasreinstatement>.

4 The process for the revised airport pass suspension policy will be as follows:

(a) Day 1: Worker does not complete a swab within the PCR RRT regime or misses 2 consecutive scheduled ART swabs.

(b) Day 2 (one-day grace period¹): CAAS informs company of the worker(s) whose airport passes may be suspended after the one-day grace period. Company may submit negative PCR swab results for workers who have done a PCR swab elsewhere.

(c) Day 3: After reviewing the submissions by the company during the one-day grace period, CAAS informs company of the worker(s) whose airport passes would be suspended.

¹ If the one-day grace period falls on a weekend/public holiday, suspension will only be effected the next working day. There will be no airport pass suspension on weekends/public holidays.
