**COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AT AIRPORT  
– 7-DAY ROSTERED ROUTINE TESTING FOR AIRPORT WORKERS**

This Circular 2021/06 is to be read in conjunction with CAAS Circular 2020/42 issued on 3 Nov 2020.

- 2 As a further enhancement to the existing precautionary measures, airport workers working in the highest risk areas are now required to undergo Rostered Routine Testing (RRT) every 7 days.
- 3 We will be contacting the relevant companies on the registration of airport workers for 7-day RRT.
- 4 Each employer must submit to CAAS its list of relevant employees who must undergo a 7-day RRT and update CAAS promptly of any changes to the list.
- 5 With immediate effect, any relevant employee who fails to undergo a scheduled RRT swab within 7 days from their previous swab will not be permitted to work at the airport. His/her airport pass will be suspended until the RRT swab test has been taken and the outcome is negative. Employers of relevant employees must therefore track and schedule their relevant employees for RRT promptly.
