**COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AT AIRPORT
– REVISED REQUIREMENTS FOR VACCINATED AIRPORT WORKERS WHO ARE
SUBJECT TO ROSTERED ROUTINE TESTING**

This Circular 2021/10 is to be read in conjunction with CAAS Circulars 2020/42 and 2021/06 issued on 3 November 2020 and 14 January 2021 respectively.

2 In view of the better protection offered by vaccination, airport workers who have completed their full course of vaccination can undergo fewer testing requirements. Those who are on the 7-day Rostered Routine Testing (RRT) will only need to be tested every 14 days. Those who are on the 14-day RRT will only need to be tested every 28 days.

3 While the frequency of RRT can be reduced after vaccination, airport workers should continue to maintain vigilance, be socially responsible, practise good personal hygiene and observe safe management measures including mask wearing and donning of personal protective equipment when needed.

4 An airport worker is considered **vaccinated** against COVID-19 if 14 days have elapsed from the date he/she has received the full vaccine regimen of an HSA-approved vaccine against COVID-19 in accordance with the process recommended by MOH (e.g. 2 doses with the second dose to be administered 21 to 25 days after the first dose for the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine).
