**COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AT AIRPORT
– GUIDELINES ON REVISED TESTING REQUIREMENTS FOR VACCINATED AIRPORT
WORKERS WHO ARE SUBJECT TO ROSTERED ROUTINE TESTING (RRT)**

This Circular 2021/15 is to be read in conjunction with CAAS Circulars 2020/42 of 3 November 2020, 2021/06 of 14 January 2021 and 2021/10 of 21 January 2021.

2 An airport worker who has completed the vaccination regimen may undergo fewer testing requirements. An airport worker on the 14-day RRT regime who has completed the vaccination regimen, will transit to a 28-day RRT regime. Similarly, an airport worker on the 7-day RRT regime who has completed the vaccination regimen, will transit to a 14-day regime. For an airport worker to complete the vaccination regimen, he/she is required to maintain his/her existing RRT regime for 2 weeks after the 2nd vaccination jab. This is because the airport worker will be **considered vaccinated** only 2 weeks after his/her 2nd vaccination jab. The airport worker will then have to complete a **step-down RRT swab** after the 2 weeks, based on his existing RRT regime (7-day or 14day). Following which, the worker will transition to a lower frequency of testing. Please refer to the worked example in **Annex A** which explains the change of RRT regime.

3 Please note the following:

- a. Each employer must submit to CAAS its full nominal roll of relevant employees who must undergo RRT. This nominal roll will include both vaccinated workers and workers who are not intending/unable to be vaccinated
- b. The excel template for the nominal roll is attached in the email sent to companies. It can also be downloaded at <https://go.gov.sg/nrtemp1rrt>.
- c. The submission must be uploaded to the online form at <https://go.gov.sg/ewevv9>. Companies may also scan the QR Code below to access the form.

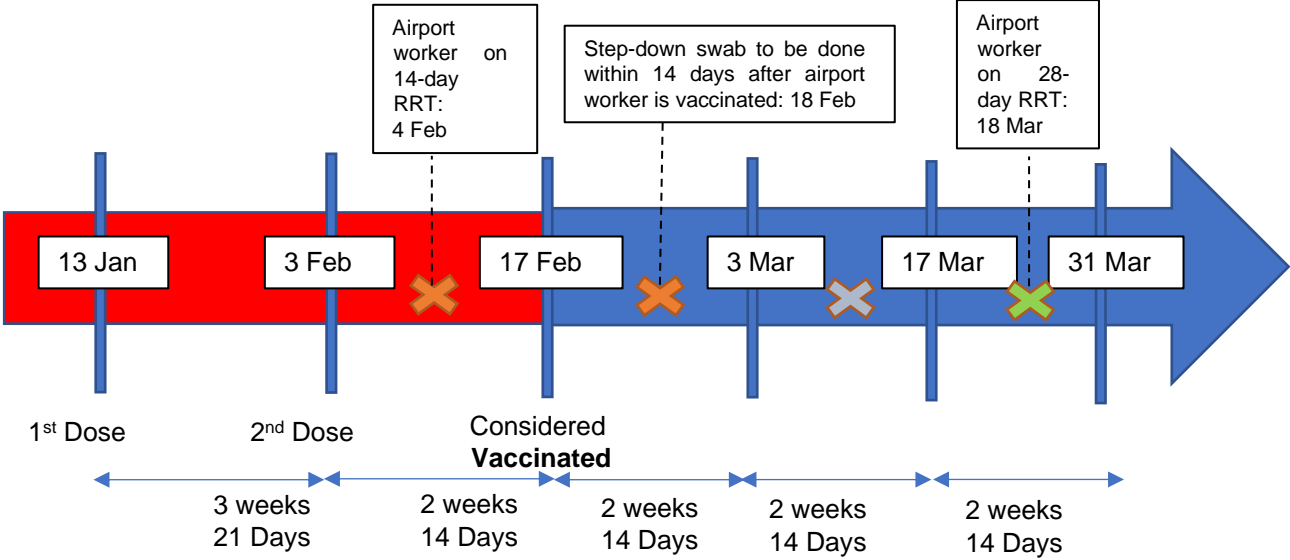
- d. The first submission must reach CAAS by **10am, 17th February 2021**. The next submission must reach CAAS by 10am, 24th February 2021. Subsequent submissions must reach CAAS by 10am every Wednesday. Note that for all submissions, companies must submit the full updated nominal roll, and not just the changes.

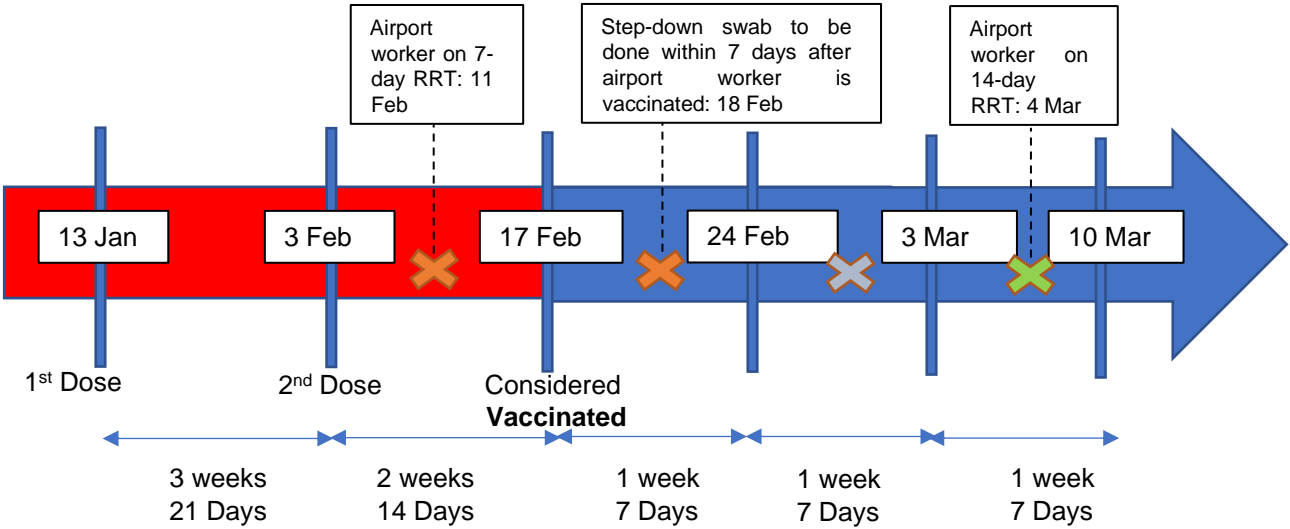
