**ROUND 2 OF TIME-LIMITED 8 WEEKS ROSTERED ROUTINE TESTING (RRT)  
FOR WORKPLACES**

This circular provides an update to the application and delivery details for Round 2 of Time Limited Rostered Routine Testing (TLRRT) and should be read together with CAAS Circular 2021/59 “Time-Limited 8 Weeks Rostered Routine Testing (RRT) for Workplaces”.

2. In addition to the eligibility criteria in CAAS Circular 2021/59, employees who are unvaccinated and recovered from COVID-19 within 180 days as of 31 March 2022 are also eligible to apply for the kits. This is because these employees are accorded similar treatment as fully vaccinated or medically ineligible employees (i.e., not unvaccinated by choice) under the Workforce Vaccination Measures and are still allowed to return to the workplace without Pre-Event Testing (PET). We also wish to reiterate that companies should exclude employees on mandatory RRT from their application of ART kits i.e., those already on mandatory RRT should not apply for the kits.

4. Companies who have successfully applied for the kits will be informed of their delivery up to 10 working days from the time of application. To facilitate resolution of delivery issues, MOH has also set up a Delivery Enquiries Form (link: <https://go.gov.sg/tlrrt-round-2-delivery-enquiry>) where companies may submit queries regarding the status of delivery (e.g., late delivery, issues with no. of kits received, rescheduling of delivery date). HPB will reach out to these companies as soon as possible, after they received their enquiry via the form.

5. From mid-Jan onwards, MOH will reject Round 2 of TLRRT applications from companies which did not comply with the requirements of the earlier round of TLRRT, as a penalty.
