ADVISORY ON MANAGING MEDICAL EVACUATION

We would like to bring to your attention that the Singapore Ministry of Health (MOH) has put in place additional measures for compliance by receiving hospitals in Singapore, in relation to medical evacuations (medevac) into Singapore, under the current context of COVID-19.

2 Airlines intending to carry out medevac patients on their flights into Singapore should ensure that MOH's requirements pertaining to medevac are strictly complied with by the various parties involved in the medevac, including the hospital that receives the patient.

3 With immediate effect, airlines are to keep CAAS (email: CAAS_FS_FOS@caas.gov.sg) informed of any intended medevac at least 48 hours before accepting any medevac assignments. CAAS may impose additional conditions on such medevac as necessary.
