**AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO DIRECTIVE NO. 12 OF 2021 (CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS ENTERING SINGAPORE UNDER VACCINATED TRAVEL LANE)**

Pursuant to section 4H(1)(a) of the Air Navigation Act, the Chief Executive of the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (also known by the designation “Director-General of Civil Aviation”), acting under power delegated to him by the Authority, considers it necessary to issue Directive No. 12/2021 (Amendment No. 4) at the **Annex** in the interests of protecting public health because of the global COVID-19 situation.

**AIR NAVIGATION ACT  
(CHAPTER 6, Section 4H(1)(a))**

**DIRECTIVE NO. 12/2021 (CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS ENTERING

(AMENDMENT NO. 4)**

**Part 1**

**Citation and Commencement**

1. This Directive is the Directive No. 12/2021 (Amendment No. 4) and comes into operation from 1559hrs GMT 31 October 2021.

**Part 2**

**Amendments**

**Amendment of paragraph 6**

4. Paragraph 6 of the principal Directive is deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:

“6.-(1) Unless otherwise specified by the DGCA, an air operator of a VTL flight must, before commencement of the VTL flight —

- (a) require every VTL passenger and every connecting passenger to:
  - (i) provide an acceptable proof, which has been notified by the DGCA in writing as such, that the passenger has been fully vaccinated;
  - (ii) provide proof, in accordance with Directive No. 9/2021 or Directive No. 10/2021, as the case may be, that the passenger has taken a pre-departure test for COVID-19;
- (b) require every VTL passenger:
  - (i) to make a declaration on the countries or regions that he or she has been in (including any country or region in which he or she

was in transit), in the last 14 consecutive days prior to departure for Singapore<sup>1</sup>; and

(iii) who is not a Singapore Citizen (“SC”) or Singapore Permanent Resident (“SPR”):

(A) to provide a valid Vaccinated Travel Pass; and

(B) to provide proof that he or she has downloaded on his or her mobile communication device the TraceTogether application with mobile number and profile registered<sup>2</sup>, unless the passenger is a Long-Term Pass Holder.

(2) Unless otherwise specified by the DGCA —

(a) an air operator must not board any VTL passenger or connecting passenger on a VTL flight who:

(i) fails to provide the proof of vaccination status mentioned in paragraph 6(1)(a)(i);

(ii) fails to provide the proof required under paragraph 6(1)(a)(ii), or whose pre-departure test for COVID-19 taken in accordance with paragraph 6(1)(a)(ii) has a positive result;

(b) an air operator must not board a VTL passenger mentioned in paragraph 6(1)(b) who:

(i) has, at any time within the last 14 consecutive days prior to that VTL flight, been in or transited through a country that is not a VTL country or Singapore;

(ii) fails to provide a valid Vaccinated Travel Pass mentioned in paragraph 6(1)(b)(ii)(A); or

(iii) fails to download the TraceTogether application on his or her mobile communication device or does not have a confirmation for a booking for a mobile communication device as described

<sup>1</sup> To illustrate, if the scheduled day of departure of the flight is D (e.g. 19 November 2021), the last 14 consecutive days refer to D-14 to D (i.e. 5 November 2021 to 19 November 2021).

<sup>2</sup> A passenger may also provide confirmation in electronic or hard copy form that the passenger has reserved for his or her use, from an approved service provider at Changi Airport, a mobile communication device on which the TraceTogether application will be downloaded, or a Singapore SIM card to register on the TraceTogether application on his or her mobile communication device. A passenger who is unable to use a mobile device due to a certified disability or special need, can be issued with a TraceTogether token at Changi Airport in lieu of a mobile device with the TraceTogether application.

in paragraph 6(1)(b)(ii)(B), unless the passenger is a Long-Term Pass Holder.

(3) To avoid doubt, paragraphs 6(1)(b) and 6(2)(b) do not apply to a connecting passenger travelling to Singapore on a VTL flight.”.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 11**

5. Paragraph 11(a) of the principal Directive is deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:

“(a) Directive No. 9/2021 or Directive No. 10/2021, as the case may be; and”.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 12**

6. Paragraph 12 of the principal Directive is deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:

“12. The DGCA may require any air operator to which this Directive applies to demonstrate compliance with the arrangements, measures and requirements set out in this Directive.”.
