



AMENDMENT NO. 17 TO DIRECTIVE NO. 9 OF 2020 (COVID-19 MEASURES FOR SINGAPORE AIR OPERATORS)

Pursuant to section 4H(1)(a) of the Air Navigation Act, the Chief Executive of the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (also known by the designation "Director-General of Civil Aviation"), acting under power delegated to him by the Authority, considers it necessary to issue Directive No. 9/2020 (Amendment No. 17) as attached in the interests of protecting public health because of the global COVID-19 situation.

2 Directive No. 9/2020 (Amendment No. 17) takes effect from 1559 hrs GMT 27 November 2021.

AIR NAVIGATION ACT (CHAPTER 6, Section 4H(1)(a))

DIRECTIVE NO. 9/2020 (COVID-19 MEASURES FOR SINGAPORE AIR OPERATORS) (AMENDMENT NO. 17)

Part 1

Citation and Commencement

1. This Directive is the Directive No. 9/2020 (Amendment No. 17) and comes into operation from 1559hrs GMT 27 November 2021.

Part 2

Amendments

Amendment of paragraph 8

- 2. Paragraph 8 of Directive No. 9/2020 (called in this Amendment No. 17 the principal Directive) is deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:
 - "8. A Singapore air operator must require cabin crew to monitor passengers in order to identify any passenger who appears to be showing any COVID-19 symptom during the flight, including taking the passenger's temperature during flight if necessary to check for fever.".

Amendment of paragraph 9

- 3. Paragraph 9 of the principal Directive is deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:
 - "9 If a crew member or passenger becomes unwell and shows any COVID-19 symptom during a flight, the Singapore air operator must arrange for the unwell crew member or passenger to receive medical attention upon landing."
