AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO DIRECTIVE NO. 4 OF 2022 (COVID-19 – MEASURES FOR FOREIGN AIR OPERATORS)

Pursuant to section 22(1)(a) of the Air Navigation Act 1966, the Chief Executive of the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (also known by the designation "Director-General of Civil Aviation"), acting under power delegated to him by the Authority, considers it necessary to issue Directive No. 4/2022 (Amendment No. 2) as attached in the interests of protecting public health because of the global COVID-19 situation.

- The DGCA considers that, in respect of this Directive No. 4/2022 (Amendment No. 2), it is not practicable to give a notice under section 22(5) of the Air Navigation Act 1966.
- 3 Directive No. 4/2022 (Amendment No. 2) takes effect from 1559 hrs GMT 28 February 2023.

Part 1

Citation and Commencement

1. This Directive is Directive No. 4/2022 (Amendment No. 2) and comes into operation from 1559 hrs GMT 28 February 2023.

Part 2

Amendments

Deletion of paragraphs 4, 7, 8 and 10

2. In Directive No. 4/2022 (called in this Amendment 2 the principal Directive), delete paragraphs 4, 7, 8 and 10.

Amendment of paragraph 11

3. In paragraph 11 of the principal Directive, delete the definitions of "COVID-19 test", "COVID-19 symptoms" and "fever".
