

Key Elements of Singapore – Hong Kong Air Travel Bubble

1.	Eligibility	Any person who has remained in Singapore and/or Hong Kong in the last 14 consecutive days prior to departure is eligible to travel. Holders of Work Permits or S-Passes issued by the Singapore Ministry of Manpower working in the construction, marine shipyard, or process sectors are excluded from travelling from Singapore to Hong Kong on the ATB.																								
2. 3.	Testing	<p>Pre-Departure COVID-19 Testing. Travellers are required to take a pre-departure COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test within 72 hours before the scheduled departure time of the designated ATB flight and obtain a negative test result.</p> <p><u>Departing from Singapore</u></p> <p>All travellers departing from Singapore to Hong Kong will need to apply for approval to take their pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test if they plan to take their COVID-19 PCR test before 1 December 2020¹. They need to apply for approval at least 7 days before departure and will need a confirmed flight ticket to Hong Kong in order to apply. To apply, please visit https://go.gov.sg/caasptd.</p> <p>Upon the receipt of an application approval via email, travellers can contact and take their test at one of the recognised clinics/testing centres/testing institutions in Singapore. ¹ From 1 December 2020, travellers need not apply for approval to take the pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test in Singapore.

		<p><u>Departing from Hong Kong</u></p> <p>Travellers² are required to take a pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours before the scheduled departure time of the designated ATB flight and obtain a negative test result. Travellers can contact and take their test at one of the recognised clinics/testing centres/testing institutions in Hong Kong. The list can be found at https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/List_of_recognised_laboratories RTPCR.pdf.</p> <p>Post-Arrival COVID-19 Testing. All travellers arriving in Hong Kong are required to take a COVID-19 test upon arrival at Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA). Travellers must book and pay for the post-arrival COVID-19 PCR test at Hong Kong International Airport before departing Singapore.</p> <p>Travellers must remain in HKIA until they receive their negative test results.</p> <p>Refer to Hong Kong's dedicated ATB website http://www.tourism.gov.hk/travelbubble for more information regarding the requirements to travel to Hong Kong.</p>
4.	Other Requirements	<p><u>Public Health Measures</u></p> <p>Travellers must comply with the prevailing public health and safe distancing measures in Singapore and Hong Kong. These include mask wearing and restrictions on group gatherings.</p> <p><u>Medical costs</u></p> <p>Should travellers become COVID-19 positive while in Singapore or Hong Kong, they will need to bear the full cost of any medical treatment, subject to the respective cities' prevailing medical and healthcare policies.</p> <p><u>Air Travel Pass</u></p> <p>Foreign travellers³ from Hong Kong will need to apply for Air Travel Pass between seven and thirty calendar days prior to their intended date of entry into Singapore. Travellers can apply for the ATP from 12 November 2020, 8am (Singapore time) for entry into Singapore on or after 22 November 2020. More details can be found at https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg.</p>

²Children aged 12 or younger in that calendar year are not required to undergo a pre-departure COVID-19 PCR test before departing Hong Kong for Singapore.

³ Singapore Citizens, Singapore Permanent Residents and Singapore Long-Term Pass holders are not required to apply for an ATP. LTP holders refer to Work Pass holders, Student's Pass holders, Long-Term Visit Pass holders and Dependant's Pass holders, as well as those who have been granted In-Principle Approval for a LTP. LTP holders need to apply for an Approval Letter for Entry as per the arrangement today.



		<p><u>TraceTogether</u> To facilitate the contact tracing process, foreign travellers from Hong Kong will be required to download and register for the TraceTogether app on their mobile devices prior to departing for Singapore, keep it activated during their stay here, and not delete it for 14 consecutive days after leaving Singapore.</p>
5.	Suspension	<p>The ATB will be suspended for two weeks if the seven-day moving average of the daily number of unlinked COVID-19 cases is more than five in either Singapore or Hong Kong.</p> <p>If the seven-day moving average of the daily number of unlinked COVID-19 cases on the last day of the suspension period is five or less, the ATB arrangement will resume.</p>
