## MOU on Strategic Collaboration in Aviation Al Capability and Talent Development

This MOU was signed between CAAS, Changi Airport Group (CAG), SATS, Singapore Airlines (SIA) and AI Singapore to signal the intent for the sector to invest in AI and technology to empower the workforce and raise labour productivity, through joint efforts in AI promotion, adoption and talent development in the sector.

- 2 Under this MOU, CAAS, CAG, SATS, SIA and AI Singapore will collaborate through the following streams:
  - a) Establish an Aviation AI Community of Practice to create a formal structure that brings the ecosystem together. This will enable stakeholders to develop AI solutions for aviation use cases and foster greater knowledge sharing and experience exchange, ultimately promoting AI adoption across the sector;
  - b) Build up a pool of AI talent within the aviation sector tapping on AI-SG's networks and programmes to develop and upskill in-sector professionals and train new AI talents joining the sector; and
  - c) Co-develop an Aviation-focused Al Roadmap to identify shared strategic priorities, key enablers and desired sector-wide outcomes, while allowing individual aviation partners to explore and implement new Al initiatives that align with these priorities and deliver operational value.
