

## **NOTICE OF AMENDMENT**

## Air Navigation (101- Unmanned Aircraft Operations) (Amendment) Regulations 2020

Please be informed that the Air Navigation (101 – Unmanned Aircraft Operations) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 has been published in the Government Gazette on 8 May 2020.

The key amendments effect the following:

- (a) Defer the effective date of the requirement to hold an unmanned aircraft ("UA") pilot licence from 1 June 2020 to 1 February 2021 for:
  - (i) the operation of a UA for a non-recreation or non-education purpose regardless of the weight, or of a UA exceeding 7 kg for any purpose; and
  - (ii) the application for the grant of an authorisation as an Authorised Flight Examiner.
- (b) Defer the effective date of the requirement to hold a UA basic training certificate in order to operate a UA exceeding 1.5 kg and not exceeding 7 kg for a recreation or education purpose from 1 June 2020 to 1 February 2021.
