

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Revisions to Advisory Circulars to provide guidance on the collection of experience for Schedule of Experience (SOE) and On-the-Job Training (OJT)

The Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 145 (SAR-145) was recently amended to require SAR-145 Approved Maintenance Organisations (AMO) to include in their expositions, a programme for their staff applying for an aircraft maintenance licence (AML) to acquire requisite practical experience.

Arising from the SAR-145 amendment:

- AC 145-14 is issued to provide guidance to the AMO on a programme for relevant staff to acquire the practice experience required in SAR-66; and
- AC 66-2 has been revised to provide guidance to an AML candidate on the collection of Schedule of Experience (SOE) and On-the-Job Training (OJT) from such AMOs.

Both ACs comes into effect on 26 November 2020 and can be found at the <u>CAAS</u> website.
