

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendment to Airworthiness Notices

Please be informed that the following Airworthiness Notices have been cancelled.

- 1) B8 Renewal of Certificates of Airworthiness
- B10 Acceptance standards for the maintenance, overhaul, repair of secondhand imported aircraft for which a Singapore Certificate of Airworthiness is sought
- 3) C2 Tyre wear limits
- 4) C5 Suspected Unapproved Parts
- 5) C14 Gas turbine engine parts subject to retirement or ultimate (scrap) lives
- 6) C21 Fatigue lives
- 7) B11 Recognition of the Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF) Qualified Senior Technicians' experience as Aeronautical Engineering experience
- 8) B12 Aircraft maintenance examination credits for graduates of Aeronautical Engineering diploma programmes conducted by Singapore Polytechnic and Ngee Ann Polytechnic

The contents in items (1) to (6) have already been incorporated into existing Air Navigation Regulations, Technical Requirements or Advisory Circulars. Items (7) and (8) are no longer valid.

The abovementioned changes comes into effect on 4 April 2020, and can be found in Airworthiness Notices Issue 26 at our <u>CAAS website</u>.
