	<b>Description</b>	<p><b>Note: This SIB is issued to revise the reference publication FAA FDC NOTAM 5/9549 to FAA KICZ NOTAM A0019/15 and introduce reference to EASA SIB No.:2014-24R2</b></p> <p>CAAS draws AOC holders' attention to the above reference publications published by ICAO and other aviation authorities regarding the safety of civil aircraft operating in Baghdad FIR. Due to the ongoing armed conflict in Iraq, civil aircraft operating in Baghdad FIR are at risk from anti-aircraft weapons causing a potentially hazardous situation.</p>
	<b>Recommendation(s)</b>	<p><b>Assess flight safety risk in Baghdad FIR and at airports of Iraq.</b></p> <p>Singapore AOC holders are strongly urged to use this, and any other pertinent information, to assess flight safety risk in the Baghdad FIR and at airports of Iraq. Singapore AOC holders are also encouraged to contact their respective Principal Operations Inspectors (POIs) to share any additional information regarding the threat and risk to safety and security of civil aviation.</p>
