

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendment to Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 21

Please be informed that the Singapore Airworthiness Requirements Part 21 (SAR-21) Certification of Products and Articles and of Design and Production Organisations has been amended to update that design data issued by design approval holders for design changes or repairs under the following Technical Arrangements are acceptable to CAAS:

- (a) Technical Arrangement on Airworthiness Certification under the Memorandum of Understanding between CAAS and the National Civil Aviation Agency of Brazil (ANAC) for the Promotion of Civil Aviation Safety;
- (b) Technical Arrangement for Airworthiness and Environmental Certification under the Memorandum of Understanding between the Civil Aviation Authority of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (UK CAA) and CAAS;
- (c) Technical Arrangement on Airworthiness Certification between CAAS and Transport Canada Civil Aviation (TCCA).

The SAR-21 (Amendment 11) comes into effect on 1 July 2025 and can be found at the CAAS website.
