

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Revision 1 to AC 92-2-2 on Guidance on Dangerous Goods Carried in Passenger and Crew Baggage

Please be informed that Advisory Circular (AC 92-2-2) on Guidance on Dangerous Goods Carried in Passenger and Crew Baggage has been revised to incorporate new limits on a lithium battery's energy capacity used to determine whether a portable electronic device should be completely switched off when carried in checked baggage.

Based on the revised requirement, devices powered by small lithium batteries in checked baggage (such as a small Bluetooth enabled tracker) need not be completely switched off if the device contains lithium batteries not exceeding 0.3 grams of lithium content for lithium metal batteries, or 2.7 Watt-hour rating for lithium ion batteries.

Revision 1 to AC 92-2-2 comes into effect on 11 May 2023 and can also be found at our CAAS website.
