CHANGES IN CAAS' SAFETY REGULATION GROUP LEADERSHIP

- This circular informs industry and stakeholders of the changes to key appointment holders in the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) Safety Regulation Group.
- With effect from 1 September 2020, CAAS has formed a new Unmanned Systems Group (USG) to facilitate and regulate the growth and integration of unmanned systems technologies, and advance safe and resilient civil aviation operations. With the formation of the USG, Mr Tan Kah Han was appointed Senior Director (Unmanned Systems Group) and relinquished his appointments in the Safety Regulation Group.
- 3 The following are changes to the key appointment holders in the Safety Regulation Group:
 - (a) Mr Alan Foo was appointed as Acting Senior Director (Safety Regulation Group), and concurrently as Director (Flight Standards) and Director (Airworthiness Certification).
 - (b) Mr Dalen Tan was appointed as Director (Safety Planning and Policy).
