ntroduction	1

- **GENERAL.** Pursuant to Paragraph 88B of the Air Navigation Order, the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) may, from time to time, issue advisory circulars (ACs) on any aspect of safety in civil aviation. This AC contains information about standards, practices and procedures acceptable to CAAS. The revision number of the AC is indicated in parenthesis in the suffix of the AC number.
- **PURPOSE.** This AC is issued to notify that the requirements relating to the conversion of foreign professional pilot licence are now found in the SASP 2 and that it cancels all previous AC relating to this subject.
- **APPLICABILITY.** This AC applies to holders of a foreign professional pilot licence who wish to convert to a Singapore equivalent in order to work as a pilot for a Singapore AOC Holder.
- 4 CANCELLATION. This AC supersedes AC FCL-1(1) dated 1 November 2007.
- **5 EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Advisory Circular is effective on 23 November 2011.
