

## NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

## Amendments to Singapore Airworthiness Requirements (SAR) Part 66 and Part 147

Please be informed that the Singapore Airworthiness Requirements (SAR) Part 66 and Part 147 have been amended.

Amendment 4 to Issue 2 of SAR-66 includes:

- changes to the basic knowledge requirements and examination format, effective 1 July 2013;
- enhancement to the level of Human Factors training for Category A technicians, effective 1 July 2013;
- extension of privileges for Category B2 aircraft maintenance engineers (AME), to include certification of electrical and avionics tasks in powerplant and mechanical systems (currently granted under a "limited" Category B1 licence), provided the AME has completed the necessary training; and
- removal of the pre-requisite for an applicant to first complete the relevant SAR-147 approved basic training course before sitting for a basic knowledge examination.

**Amendment 3 to Issue 1 of SAR-147** includes, in Section 2 of SAR-147, aircraft type/task training for new ATA 100 chapters.

These amendments come into effect on 8 March 2013.
