Eligibility

- 1 To qualify for the ALS, the candidate must:
 - Be a Singapore Citizen
 - Be a full time employee of an eligible company in the airline or airport sector.
 - Have at least 5 years of aviation working experience at the time of application
 - Have at least 2 years of supervisory / managerial duties
- 2 Singapore-based companies in the airport and airline sectors with at least 30% of their revenues from airport and airline businesses are eligible to nominate their employees for the ALS, becoming a Sponsoring Company. The Sponsoring Company shall:
 - Ensure that the scholar selects a course relevant to his/her work. The course shall be approved by both the Sponsoring Company and CAAS. Only parttime courses can be supported.
 - Ensure that the scholar completes his/her Masters within 4 years, and PhD within 7 years, and implement a minimum service period of 1 year with the Sponsoring Company upon the completion of studies.
 - Provide the necessary support for the scholar, in terms of time off and study leave, to enable the scholar to fulfill his / her study obligations.
 - Disburse the ALS award to the scholar.
 - Commit to the career development of the scholar. A clear career progression plan for the candidate should be shown in the application.
