Understanding the Foreign Operator Surveillance Programme

13 November 2015, Singapore Aviation Academy

As a safety regulator and in line with ICAO standards, CAAS conducts safety surveillance of foreign operators' aircraft that operate into and out of Singapore. Accordingly, CAAS requires foreign operators flying into and out of Singapore commercially to hold an Operations Permit. As part of safety surveillance, ramp inspections are also conducted on the foreign operator's aircraft when they are in Singapore.

It has been more than 2 years since CAAS has introduced the enhanced framework on the safety surveillance of foreign operators, termed as the Foreign Operator Surveillance Programme (FOSP). In this seminar, you will be briefed on CAAS safety regulations, as well as the approach and methodology to perform Confidence Level Assessment and Continued Surveillance on the foreign operators and their aircraft. You will also be updated on the latest developments in CAAS regulations. Feedback garnered from foreign operators and their handling agents since the introduction of the FOSP will also be shared, including CAAS' responses to these feedback. You will also have the opportunity to ask questions or seek further clarification on the FOSP.
