

## A GLIMPSE INTO THE PAST

A half-scale, stainless steel replica of the Bristol Boxkite biplane, which first took off in Singapore 100 years ago, was unveiled by Lui Tuck Yew, Minister for Transport and Second Minister for Foreign Affairs, on the sidelines of the 4th International Advisory Council (IAC) Meeting held in the Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA) on 12 July.
