

# **CAAS AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES INITIATIVES AND EFFORTS RECEIVE INDUSTRY RECOGNITION**



In October 2009, the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS) was named Air Navigation Services Provider (ANSP) of the Year for its commitment to taking pro-active steps to promote efficient regional air traffic management and environmental responsibility in reducing fuel costs and carbon emissions. CAAS earned this award from the Centre of Asia Pacific Aviation (CAPA).

With CAPA introducing this first ever ANSP award, it highlights the increasingly vital role that air navigation services providers like CAAS play in improving air traffic management, and their impact on the environment through innovative initiatives in helping to reduce carbon emissions.

On the part of CAAS, its initiatives in this direction stem from the ground up. The company offers airlines and pilots a platform to provide feedback on ways to further improve safety and efficiency of air traffic operations through a regular forum organised by the Monthly Singapore Airport Operators Committee. To better respond to emerging events and situations, ad hoc consultations are also conducted with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) and airlines.
